Set the Tone for Dodgers Playoffs at Philippe's

Philippe's is located less than two miles from Dodger stadium and directly across the street from Union Station, where you can catch a free ride with your gameday ticket on the [Dodger Stadium Express](#) bus. Service leaves Union Station every 10 minutes starting 90 minutes before the game.

Outside food is permitted at Dodger Stadium as long as it's in a clear tote, so don't forget a few French Dips for the road. Philippe's also sells a clear, [stadium-approved game day tote](#) at the candy counter and online.
